

Ballot

To vote, follow the steps below:

1. Print out the ballot. Then mark the box(es) to the left of the name(s) you wish to vote for. Mark **4** or fewer choices for Board of Directors and mark 1 for Nominating Committee.
2. Insert the completed ballot(s) into an envelope and seal the envelope.
3. Be sure to sign your name(s) on the back side of the envelope, so we can check you off on the membership roster. Please sign legibly and print your name if your signature is difficult to read. When more than one ballot is enclosed in a single envelope, sign all names. Put only your return address on the front of the envelope, not your name.

To Turn In Your Ballot—Choose 1 of the following 3 methods:

1. Stamp and mail your envelope so that it will be received no later than April 28th. Send to

2. or bring it to the AACTMAD Annual Meeting, and turn it in no later than 4 pm on April 30 (the meeting begins at 4 pm at the Concourse Dance Hall).
3. Give your ballot to a current member of the AACTMAD Board.
